How long does it take to walk around the grounds?

We recommend you allow at least 2 hours for your visit

Is there anywhere I can buy refreshments on the grounds?

Although the Foundation does not have a café on site, we do have basic facilities for refreshments including a self-service area for tea, coffee, hot chocolate and light snacks. Our commissioned artwork 'Picnic Grove' provides visitors with a beautiful picnic area where you can enjoy your refreshments whilst taking in beautiful views.

Can we take photos?
